4. This lot (E49) runs the full width of this section and probably originated as a north-south driveway as it has a different depth dimension than the other rows of burial lots. There is no evidence of any burials here.
5. It is very probable that this monument along with several others nearby were brought to the DeWitt cemetery during the late 1800's after the abandonment by DeWitt township of its cemetery on Schavey road, formerly known as the GOODRICH cemetery.
6. These family plots (E96 & E100) are not original to this location, probably not to this cemetery, but their place of origin is yet unknown. See separate essay, "PEARSALL Lots", in this work for more information. The stones in both of these lots are in very poor condition as their close proximity to the driveway have made them vulnerable to numerous accidents.
7. "LAND PROSPECTOR, FIRST WHITE MAN TO DIE DEWITT" died at the Scott family's initial camp at the Indian village of Wabwahnahseepee, directly east of the present DeWitt. Actual burial site unknown. Origin of monument unknown.
